Dear Mr. Trusner:

This letter acknowledges your letter sent to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated January 10, 2019 (ML19011A335) that provided a response to our inspection report issued on December 14, 2018 (ML18351A162), concerning activities conducted at your Noblesville, Indiana, facility. The letter we received contested one of the three violations documented in the Notice of Violation issued with NRC Inspection Report No. 03038903/2018001(DNMS).

The contested violation is Violation C for the failure to ensure that each entrance or access point to a high radiation area has one or more of the control features described in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 20.1601(a) or continuous direct or electronic surveillance that is capable of preventing unauthorized entry as described in 10 CFR 20.1601(b). We are currently reviewing your basis for contesting this violation. The NRC seeks to be thorough and timely in the review of licensee responses. Accordingly, we will inform you as soon as we complete our evaluation.

Regarding Violation A for failure to make or cause to be made surveys that may be necessary to comply with the regulations in Part 20 and Violation B for failure to post a high radiation area with proper signage, the NRC has reviewed your corrective actions and has no further questions at this time. However, as a result of the ongoing review of Violation C, the NRC may have further questions in the future. The corrective actions may also be reviewed by the NRC during a future inspection.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390, "Public inspections, exemptions, requests for withholding," of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC's Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records System (PARS) component of the NRC's
