To Whom It May Concern:

In connection with an intercompany consolidation, the assets and liabilities of Teledyne Reynolds, Inc. have been transferred to and assumed by Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC. Teledyne Reynolds became a registered fictitious business name of Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC. Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC will continue to be a subsidiary of Teledyne Technologies Incorporated.

This intercompany consolidation was finalized on October 2, 2018. The new legal name for Teledyne Reynolds is "Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC, d/b/a Teledyne Reynolds." As such, invoices and other legal documents will reflect this new legal entity name going forward. Teledyne Reynolds will continue to operate as a division of Teledyne Defense Electronics, LLC and will continue to do business under the Teledyne Reynolds brand name.

Operations will continue at the Teledyne Reynolds facility in Torrance, California without any change in personnel, facilities, management, or operating policies. Similarly, this consolidation does not affect product qualification status and related quality assurance approvals. See attached taxpayer identification number and certification dated 10/1/2018.

## Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
  - Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
