

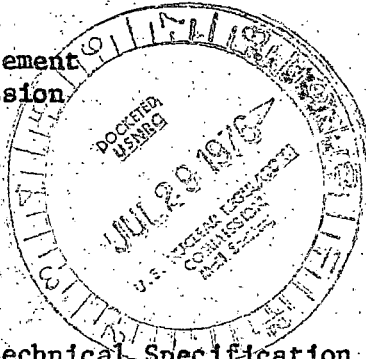

Dear Mr. Moseley:

Surry Power Station Technical Specification 4.13D states, in part, that a final report summarizing the results of the nonradiological environmental monitoring program would be submitted sixty days following the third anniversary of the date Unit No. 2 was licensed to operate.

As agreed to by the NRC Staff on March 24, 1976, this final report will be a part of the PL 92-500, Section 316(a) demonstration as described in 40 CFR, Section 122.15(b) (1) (i) and (ii). This is in accordance with the provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the Environmental Protection Agency, effective January 29, 1976.

Alternate effluent limitations and modifications to the nonradiological environmental study program will be based upon the decision resulting from the demonstration. The licensee will request a decision late in 1976.
