To whom it may concern:

As requested per your letter dated March 21, 2019, please find enclosed information about the 1998 affiliation of Greenwich Hospital Association (GHA) with Yale New Haven Health Services Corporation (YNHHS).

1. Describe any planned changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc. Provide the new licensee name, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers. Clearly identify when the amendment request is due to a name change only.

In 1998 YNHHS became the sole corporate member of Greenwich Health Care Services, Inc. (GHCSI) via a membership substitution transaction. At that time, GHCSI was the sole corporate member of GHA (the NRC license holder). That same year GHA amended its Certificate of Incorporation to re-name the corporate entity Greenwich Hospital (GH). In 2016, GHCSI merged with and into GH with GH as the surviving corporation, the sole member of which remains YNHHS. See organizational charts in Exhibit A.

YNHHS is a Connecticut non-stock corporation. GH is also a Connecticut non-stock corporation and holds the NRC license noted above. As a result of the 1998 member substitution transaction, the Chief Executive Officer of YNHHS (or her designee) serves on the Board of Trustees of GH. Even after the transactions noted herein, the assets of GH have remained with and under the control of GH, GH has maintained a local fiduciary board, its own hospital license, medical staff, management, facility, operational staff, and the same tax identification number. GH has also maintained the same physical address, policies and procedures, national provider identifier, and control of clinical programs.

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2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and any changes in the training program.

There was no change in personnel and their duties, or location, facilities, equipment and the radiation safety program as a result of the 1998 affiliation.

3. Describe any changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

No changes as a result of the 1998 affiliation.

4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

All required records regarding the use and possession of licensed materials are current. There have been no known contaminations and the facility has been surveyed by NRC as recently as May 15, 2017.

5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name before the license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(t), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.

Not applicable.

6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

All records are maintained by GH at its current location, which did not change as a result of the 1998 affiliation.

7. Confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.

Control of the licensed material and activity will remain with GH. There are no open inspection items.

8. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

YNHHS and GH so confirm.

**9. The transferee, in the case of fuel cycle facilities, shall provide documentation showing that it is financially qualified to conduct normal operations. The information can be in the form of income statements and balance sheet forecasts.
SJMh maintains a materials license.**

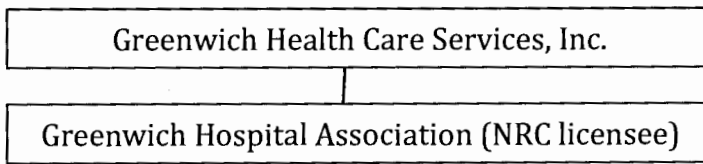

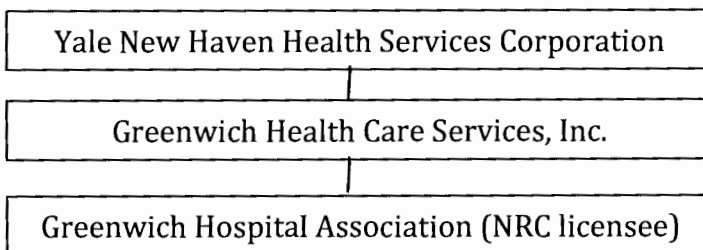

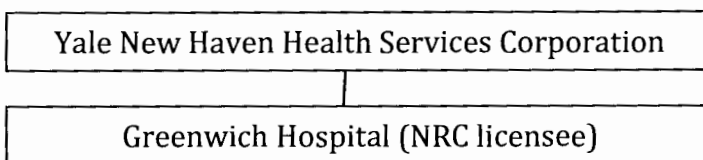
Pre-Affiliation with YNHHS
