Dear Mr. Volgenau,

The following is in response to your April 4, 1977, letter in which you requested support by Pennsylvania Power & Light Company in establishing a communication path between our Susquehanna Project employees, who have safety concerns, and the NRC.

We are most anxious to promptly surface concerns of our own and contractor employees about the safety features of this project. The NRC posting procedure should provide additional assurance that these concerns will be exposed. Consequently, we are proceeding with immediate implementation of your request. During a future inspection, we will welcome comments by Region I inspectors regarding the adequacy of our postings.

I feel that it is appropriate and desirable for NRC to keep us advised of your experience with this procedure. I realize, of course, that significant safety issues will be brought to our attention promptly. The procedure, however, can offer the additional advantage of providing awareness of the attitude and knowledge of our employees so that improved communications with them can be developed.
