Gentlemen:

With reference to the construction permit application for Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, the Attorney General has furnished the Commission antitrust advice pursuant to section 103c of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. A copy of the Attorney General's letter dated April 28, 1972 is enclosed for your information.

We are also transmitting to the Office of the Federal Register a copy of the Attorney General's advice for publication. It should be noted that pursuant to section 2.714 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 10 CFR Part 2, a petition for leave to intervene and request for hearing on the antitrust aspects of the application may be filed by any person whose interest may be affected within thirty (30) days after publication of the notice in the Federal Register.

The antitrust review function of the Atomic Energy Commission has been assigned to the Office of Antitrust and Indemnity. Future correspondence dealing with antitrust matters should be addressed to this Office.
