CITIZENS AGAINST NUCLEAR DANGERS MOVE FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER BY THE
BOARD AGAINST THE MASSIVE AMOUNTS OF DISCOVERY DOCUMENTATION DEMANDED
BY THE NRC STAFF, WHICH IS "OPPRESSIVE AND INAPPROPRIATELY
BURDENSOME" UNDER THE COMMISSIONS RULES OF PROCEDURE (#2,740 (C)),

THE CITIZENS ALSO PETITIONED THE BOARD TO DENY THE MOTION OF THE NRC
STAFF AGAINST THE CITIZENS, BECAUSE THE CITIZENS DID PROPERLY COMPLY
WITH THE ORDER OF AUGUST 24, 1979.

THE FACT THAT, BECAUSE OF THE FAILURE OF THE NRC STAFF TO ISSUE THE
(FES) AND THE (SER) ON SCHEDULE, THE PUBLIC HEARINGS ON ENVIRONMENTAL
ISSUES WILL NOT BE HELD UNTIL MARCH 1980 AT THE EARLIEST. IT IS,
THEREFORE, NO LONGER IMPERATIVE THAT ALL DISCOVERY BE CONCLUDED AT
THIS TIME...6 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE FIRST SET OF HEARINGS.
