Dear Mr. Svoboda:

I am reviewing your application for an NRC license and need some additional information to complete the review.

1. The location specified where the licensed material will be used or possessed is 116 Carriage Lane, Saint Marys, WV.
  - A. Please describe the location and the conditions in which the gauge will be stored. Provide a facility diagram for each permanent storage location. Include on the diagram the use of adjacent areas (including above and below), and information relevant to public dose and security as discussed in NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 2, sections 8.10.5 (Public Dose) and 8.10.6 (Operating, Emergency, & Security procedures).
  - B. If the diagram shows the exact location of use and storage for any amount of radioactive material, then the diagram should be marked as "Security Related Information—Withhold under 10 CFR 2.390."
  - C. Will the device be used at this location or only stored there?
  - D. Will the storage location be used on nights and weekends, or other periods? Do you expect to return the device to this location at the end of the work day?
2. You did not request authorization to use the gauge at temporary job sites. Do you intend to use the gauge at temporary job locations in NRC jurisdiction?
3. You requested possession of one "CPN MCIDR" gauge. The available manufacturer's literature appears to designate this gauge as a "Model MC-1 DR". Please confirm that the device to be possessed is a "CPN Model MC-1 DR".

Please provide the requested information as soon as possible, and within 30 days from the date of this message. Responses received after more than 30 days may not be considered in the review, and it may be necessary to void the application without the requested information.
