Dear Mr. Bayt:

In letter dated March 8, 2019 (ML19100A057), Daniel Polsky of BWGS, LLC contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that he wished to terminate NRC License No. 13-35481-01. In that letter, he provided information that BWGS LLC had distributed all licensed material to Grow Generation Corporation. In your letter dated July 8, 2019 (ML19189A161), you confirmed that all residual licensed material from BWGS LLC had been removed from its Mooresville, Indiana facilities, listed on the referenced license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20, subpart E, and is ALARA.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the BWGS, LLC, 1410 Hancel Pkwy., Mooresville, IN 46158, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 13-35481-01 is hereby terminated.
