We have reviewed your letter dated April 24, 2019 requesting to name a new Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Patrick S. Barber, Ph.D., for NRC License No. 13-05737-01 which was issued to Earlham College. The criteria we used for the review is listed in Section 8.7.1, "Radiation Safety Officer", in NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Revision 1 (<https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v7/>). We will need additional information regarding his training and experience related to your radiation safety program. Please provide the following information.

- 1) When did he complete the radiation safety training at University of Nevada – Reno and Earlham College? Did he review Earlham College's operating and emergency procedures related to the radiation safety?
- 2) How many years has he worked with radioactive materials?
- 3) How long has he worked with the Co-60 and Cs-137 sources and the neutron howitzer listed in your license? If he has not worked with your licensed materials, please provide information that he worked with the isotopes, chemical/physical form, and in quantities equivalent to or the same with licensed materials listed in your license.
- 4) Provide his official contact information.
