The Commonwealth of Massachusetts hereby moves that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (the Board) order that the direct testimony of the Applicant's Panel No. 1 (Messrs. Weiner, Legrow, Bourcier, and Barstow) and of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Panel (Mr. Chernick and Ms. Geller) be heard no sooner than Monday, July 23, 1979 and states as the reasons therefore as follows:

1. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts properly served interrogatories upon the Applicant pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §2.740b on or about June 8, 1979. These interrogatories were exclusively concerned with the testimony of the Applicant's Panel No. 1.
2. The answers to these interrogatories were due, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. §2.740b, on or about June 22, 1979.
