

Commonwealth did not oppose this request, despite the fact that all parties were aware of the scheduled resumption of hearings on the "need for power" issue on Monday, July 16, 1979

4. The Applicant served their responses to the Commonwealth's interrogatories upon the Commonwealth in the afternoon of Thursday, July 12, 1979, less than 1 1/2 working days before the resumption of hearings.
5. In order to properly prepare for the Commonwealth's cross-examination of the Applicant's Panel No. 1, and in order to properly prepare the Commonwealth's Panel for cross-examination by the Applicant and by other parties, it is imperative that the Commonwealth be allowed proper time to analyze the Applicant's responses to the Commonwealth's interrogatories.

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts moves that the Board order that the direct testimony of the Applicant's Panel No. 1 (Messrs. Weiner, Legrow, Bourcier, and Darstow) and of the Commonwealth's Panel (Mr. Chernick and Ms. Geller) be heard no sooner than Monday, July 23, 1979.
