Dear Jim:

Ordinarily I don't write two letters to you in the same week. That does seem a bit excessive. But here goes:

I had heard, again fourth hand, that some of the iron at the Wolf Creek SNUPPS plant was found to be smaller than that used ordinarily at nuclear plants, and that at least in one instance a Wolf Creek welder had refused to weld it. I also was told that a truck driver told someone (who told me) that the truck driver was in the process of delivering to Callaway a load of reject iron he had picked up at Wolf Creek. That was sometime prior to March 29, 1979, but I don't know when. Do you or your colleagues in the Arlington, Texas, office know if any of this is accurate?
