


- (1) This Affidavit is being made in conformance with the provisions of 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (the Commission) regulation and in conjunction with the application for withholding accompanying this Affidavit.
- (2) Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, the following is furnished for consideration by the Commission in determining whether the information sought to be withheld from public disclosure should be withheld:
  - (i) The information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is owned and has been held in confidence by Wisconsin Electric Power Company.
  - (ii) This information is of a type customarily held in confidence by Wisconsin Electric Power Company and is not disclosed to the public. Wisconsin Electric Power Company's rational basis for this action is based on the belief that providing such information concerning the human resources of the Company could be utilized by personnel placement services and others

to disrupt and diminishes such resources, and to otherwise disadvantage the Company and its competitive position in attracting and retaining capable individuals.

- (iii) The information is being transmitted to the Commission in confidence and, under the provisions of 10 CFR Section 2.790, it is to be received in confidence by the Commission.
- (iv) The information is not available in public sources.
