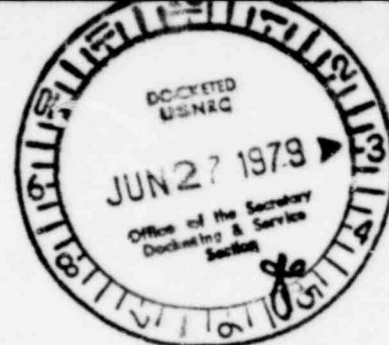

CASE NO. 80008

In the Matter of the Application of New York State Electric & Gas Corp. and Long Island Lighting Co., pursuant to Article VIII of the Public Service Law, for a certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need authorizing the construction and operation of a steam electric generating facility at a site in the Town of New Haven, County of Oswego, or at an alternate site in the Town of Stuyvesant, County of Columbia, N.Y.

INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL TO COMMISSION
ON DENIAL OF MOTION FOR DISMISSAL

Ecology Action of Oswego requested Commission review of the April 13, 1979 ruling by the Hearing examiners in Case 80008 which denied their Motion for Dismissal filed March 20, 1979. Concerned Citizens for Safe Energy in its Motion for Dismissal supported the request of Ecology Action of Oswego and continues to wholeheartedly their interlocutory appeal filed April 26, 1979.

We believe that Long Island Lighting Company is not a viable applicant in Case 80008.

We believe that Case 80008 should be dismissed for the reasons set forth by Ecology Action of Oswego.
