Dear Mr. Hendrie:

As a significant user of electric power produced by the Metropolitan Edison Co., York, Pa., we wish to express our concern with the continued shutdown of TMI Unit #1.

The greatly increased cost of power produced by alternate fuel sources has caused this plant's electric bill to rise more than \$5,000 per month compared to a year ago when TMI #1 was operational. Even more important is the waste of fossile fuels and the further aggravation of this country's foreign oil import problem that the loss of nuclear power generation creates. It is essential to the economic well being of this country that we make full use of our available nuclear power stations as well as continue to expand our nuclear powered generating capability.

The urgency of the need for lower cost electric power in this heavy industry area prompts this request for your favorable consideration of an early return to service of TMI Unit #1.
