On June 14, 1979, we verbally informed your Mr. R. G. Taylor of a possible cooling problem with the diesel generators. We submitted interim responses logged TXX-3008, 3026, and 3037, advising you that we were continuing our investigation and evaluation. We have completed our analysis and have concluded that the matter is not reportable under 10 CFR 50.55(e).
