We have reviewed Supplement No. 2 to the Environmental Report for  
Carroll County Station, Carroll County, Illinois.

In accordance with 36 CFR Part 200 and 36 CFR Part 63, the proposed  
evaluation and mitigation plan for six archeological sites that would be  
impacted by facility construction (pp. 2.6-7 to 2.6-9) should be coord-  
inated with the Illinois State Historic Preservation Officer (if this  
has not already taken place). If, during the evaluation process, any of  
these sites are found eligible for the National Register of Historic  
Places, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation must be consulted  
and its views solicited on proposed mitigation measures.
