Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

We offer the following responses to the apparent Items of Noncompliance in the referenced inspection report.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

- A. As required by 10 CFR 50.54(i-1), the licensee shall not make a change to the accepted requalification training program by which the scope, frequency, or time allotted to conducting parts of the program is reduced without prior approval of the Commission.

Contrary to the above, the licensee reduced the requirements of on-shift participation for backup licensed operators from five (5) days every four (4) months to two (2) days every three months. In addition, eight (8) backup licensed operators failed to meet either the fifteen (15) days per year or the eight (8) days per year requirement during the period from January 1, 1978 through April 1, 1979.

Response: AI-800 will be revised to revert to the requirement for on-shift participation of backup licensed operators for five (5) days every four (4) months as initially required by the program. As required by 10 CFR 50.54(i-1), future changes will not be made without prior approval of the Commission.

The AI-800 revision will be completed by 30 September 1979 and all eight (8) backup licensees will meet the requirements by 30 November 1979.

- B. As required by 10 CFR 55, Appendix A, lectures shall be conducted where performance on annual examinations indicates that additional emphasis is needed. The accepted requalification program stipulates that only those licensees who score greater than ()% on each section of the annual examination may be exempted from participation in the lecture(s) given on that section.

Contrary to the above, one licensed reactor operator and one licensed senior reactor operator scored less than 80% on a section of the 1978 annual examination administered in January of 1978 and they failed to attend a lecture covering that section during the period before the 1979 annual examination.

Response: Personnel who scored less than 80% on any section of the annual examinations will be scheduled for makeup lectures to be completed by 30 September 1979.

- C. As required by Technical Specification 6.8.1, procedures shall be written and implemented.

Contrary to the above, Procedure AI-800, Item 6.1, was not implemented in that required semi-annual evaluations were not prepared for eight (8) licensed backup operators for one or both semi-annual periods in 1978.

Response: Semi-annual evaluations will be prepared for all licensed personnel. AI-800 will be revised to be in agreement with Appendix 12C of the FSAR. This change will be completed by 30 September 1979. Semi-annual evaluations for the backup licensed operators will be completed by 30 November 1979.

- D. As required by 10 CFR 19.12, all individuals working in or frequenting any portion of a restricted area shall be instructed to report promptly to the licensee any condition which may cause or lead to a violation of Commission regulations.

Contrary to the above, the lesson plan for instructions to workers did not include such instruction material and one of six workers interviewed on June 14, 1979 stated that he was unaware of this requirement.

Response: AI-800 will be revised to include 10 CFR 19.12 instructions in the General Employee Training Program by 30 September 1979. In addition, a review of 10 CFR 19.12 will be included in the site badge training, which is given to all personnel granted unescorted access to the plant site.
