I) The plan of action and schedule with regard to items 1-8:

Several of the items are currently being done and all remaining items will be completed prior to October 5, 1979.

II) Answers to item 9 - 1, 2 and 3 are listed below:

1-2: Previously submitted in Section H of the Annual Report required by the Technical Specifications for the M.I.T. Reactor.

3: Low-level liquid radioactive waste was generated during this time period. All liquid radioactive waste is solidified using absorbent materials in accordance with burial site criteria.
