Amendment 18 to the TMI-1 License was issued July 23, 1976 in response to our requests dated January 31, July 31, August 21, September 4, and October 29, 1975. On the submittal of our request dated July 31, 1976 (Technical Specification Change Request No. 16) we requested that since Change Requests 16.3, 16.4, 16.5 and 16.6 involved changes of sampling station locations and associated moving of equipment, these changes would not be implemented immediately, but within 90 days after the date of the Technical Specification Amendment issuance.

This request, however, was not referenced on your Amendment 18 issuance letter. We are, therefore, requesting your prompt decision on this matter since as stated above, immediate compliance with the approved changes is not possible.
