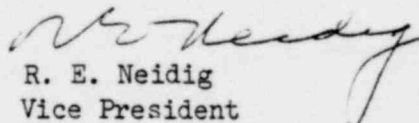
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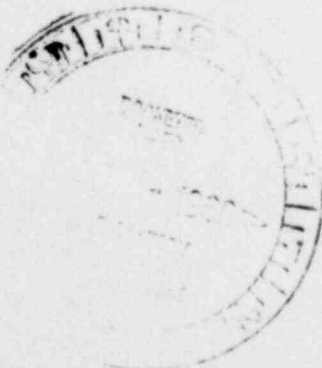
On June 27, 1968, Metropolitan Edison Company submitted to the AEC information on the 170 wire post-tensioning tendons which it was proposing to use in the Reactor Containment Building instead of the 90 wire post-tensioning tendons previously described in the application for a construction permit.
