In compliance with our Three Mile Island Nuclear Station (TMI-1) Environmental Technical Specifications Section 5.6.2.4 (Item #1, concerning changes made in, or proposed for Permits and/or Licenses), we forwarded you a letter, dated January 14, 1977 (attached for your reference) which included all those licenses and permits which are required by Federal, State, Local and Regional authorities for the protection of the environment. In that letter we indicated which of these permits were either being applied for, or which were under revision. We direct your attention to item #5 of that letter, which references our application for an Industrial Waste Permit. We have recently been granted that permit (IWP # 2276209), and enclose it for your information, as required by the above-referenced TMI-1 Environmental Technical Specifications.

We also have recently applied to the Pennsylvania Dept. of Environmental Resources for Amendments to Industrial Waste Permits #2270204 and #2276209, and to the United States Environmental Protective Agency, for Amendments to NPDES permit #0009920, to allow the use of NALCO 41-L as a corrosion inhibitor at TMI. In accordance with the above referenced Environmental Technical Specifications, enclosed please find our applications for those permit amendments and the letter of approval which we have received from the PADER. The EPA has not, as yet, responded to our amendment request.

As NALCO 41-L is proposed for use in closed systems, and will be implemented only upon the approval of the appropriate regulating agencies, it is our estimation that the environmental impact, associated with the use of NALCO 41-L in the closed cooling systems at TMI, will be negligible. This determination is based on the fact that any leakage will be treated by a low-volume, Non-Radioactive Waste Treatment Facility, which has the capacity for reducing pollutants to levels which meet both EPA and DER limitations.

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

Please note that our understanding of TMI-1 Environmental Technical Specifications Section 5.6.2.4 (Item #2) is such that; "...permits and certificates required by Federal, State, Local and Regional authorities for the protection of the environment...", includes only our Industrial Wastes and NPDES permits. If our interpretation of this Environmental Technical Specification is in error, please provide us with a listing of those permits to which the quotation indicated above applies.
