Dear Mr. Haskins:

By letter addressed to you from Mr. Lawrence Sager, dated September 18, 1973, Intervenor in the subject proceeding seek to amend "Revised Contention 7" which has already been allowed as an issue in this proceeding by the Board in its Order of September 13, 1973. Counsel for Applicants was informed on August 31, 1973, during a telephone conversation with Mr. Sager, of his intention to seek such amendment.

Applicants understand that Intervenor seek to withdraw from further consideration those portions of Contention 7 which concern "Cryogenic Radioactive Waste [Gas] Treatment System" (Tr. 174) and a "Higher Stack for Release of Radioactive Gases" (id.). Applicants further understand that Intervenor still desire to pursue that portion of Contention 7 concerning treatment by charcoal filter of the main condenser air ejector discharge, and that Intervenor seek to add in Contention 7 a new consideration related to treatment of the reactor building containment atmosphere by a charcoal filter kidney system.


