Gentlemen:

In response to your letter of September 17, 1979, concerning the implementation of the EPA Uranium Fuel Cycle Standard, 40 CRF 190, the following is provided. The existing Technical Specifications for Arkansas Nuclear One-Units 1 and 2 (ANO- 1 and 2) include objectives to assure that the release of radioactive material to unrestricted areas meets the as-low-as-reasonably achievable concept. These technical specifications objectives meet the intent of the guidelines set forth in the Concluding Statement of Position of the Regulatory Staff (Docket RM-50-2), as published under Appendix I of 10 CFR 50.

It is our understanding that if a facility meets the requirements of this "Concluding Statement of Position", it also meets the requirements of 40 CFR 190.

Since the objectives of the ANO-1 and 2 Technical Specifications were developed to conform to the "Concluding Statement of Position", we therefore feel we are in compliance with 40 CFR 190 at this time.
