Re: William P. Gammil's letter to
All Power Reactor Licensees,
dated 9/17/79.

The referenced letter noted that compliance with 40CFR190 will be required on December 1, 1979. The letter indicated that Alabama Power Company will be required to assure such compliance. It also noted that a commitment to the provisions of the Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications is an acceptable method for demonstration of conformance.

Alabama Power Company commits to the following sections of the Farley RETS, submitted to the NRC via letter of October 10, 1979: 3.11.1.2, 3.11.2.2, 3.11.2.3 and 3.11.2.5.
