Gentlemen:

This is to advise that, with respect to the Motion for a Protective Order filed by Central & South West Corporation, et al. ("CSW") on October 17, 1979 and the Response to Motion for Protective Order and Motion for Modified Protective Order filed by the Public Utilities Board of the City of Brownsville, CSW and the PUB have resolved their differences. Consequently, we respectfully request that the Licensing Board enter a Protective Order in the form attached to the PUB's response, with the following changes:

1. in numbered paragraph 1 on page 3 of the PUB's proposed Protective Order the words "to counsel for the PUB" be inserted after the word "production" in the second line;
2. On page 4, numbered paragraph 1, lines 5 and 6, the words "(including PUB personnel)" be deleted.

The proposed Protective Order is acceptable in all other respects and we request that it be entered as expeditiously as possible.
