

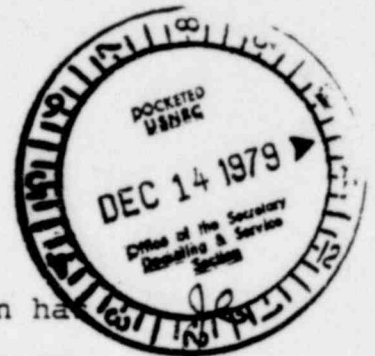

WHEREAS, the Virginia Electric and Power Company's North Anna 2 nuclear power unit has been completed since June, 1979, in compliance with NRC standards, and

WHEREAS, North Anna I has operated successfully with no events to endanger life or property, and

WHEREAS, Hanover County is a neighbor to and downstream on the North Anna River from the VEPCO nuclear facilities in Louisa County, and

WHEREAS, the delay of licensing North Anna 2 is reportedly costing VEPCO customers \$13 million per month,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on motion of
