Dear Senator Markey:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter of July 24, 2019, that expressed concerns about the adequacy of the safety culture at Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) nuclear power plants. Responses to your four questions are enclosed.

The NRC expects nuclear power plant licensees to establish and maintain a safety-conscious work environment in which employees are free and encouraged to raise safety concerns and where such concerns are promptly reviewed. Through inspections and other oversight activities, the NRC assesses the work environment and ability of employees to raise concerns at TVA.
