On November 22, 1978, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (NYSE&G) and Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) tendered an application for construction permits and all licenses required in connection with the ownership, use and operation for NYSE&G 1 & 2. The two unit nuclear powered electric generating station is to be located at the New Haven site in the County of Oswego, State of New York.
