The following is in response to Item 11 of Reference (b) which required that proposed technical specification changes be submitted, as necessary, based on our review of the Three Mile Island incident, i.e., Items 1 through 10 of Reference (b).

At this time we do not have any new changes to submit as a direct result of our efforts in reviewing and responding to IE Bulletin 79-08. A review of Vermont Yankee systems and operational practices is continuing and if any technical specifications changes are identified you will be notified. However, we do wish to reiterate that a proposed change exists (Reference (c)) on the Vermont Yankee docket which is directly related to post-accident hydrogen control; timely approval of that submittal would seem appropriate.
