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

RESPONSE TO IE BULLETIN 79-10  
FOR BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT

Each year, under the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant Requalification Program, our licensed personnel is scheduled for a minimum of ninety-six hours of instruction, followed by a final examination.

During the year 1975, all training was performed at the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant. Beginning in 1976 through 1978, sixty-four of the ninety-six hours of training were conducted at TVA's Power Production Training Center. The training center has available the certified Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant simulator which provides licensed people with "hands-on" experience. The last week of requalification training performed each year, including the annual examination, is conducted at the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant.
