Subject: Vermont Yankee Chlorination Study, May 1973

In a recent telephone conversation between us and members of your staff, the Vermont Yankee Appendix B Environmental Technical Specifications were discussed. Inclusive with that discussion was the adequacy of the imposed environmental limits of chlorine concentration in cooling water discharge during closed cycle plant operation. After an initial search of the Vermont Yankee docket file, your staff indicated to us that more background information relative to this matter would be needed and requested a copy of the Vermont Yankee Chlorination Study conducted during May of 1973.
