PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

The Ulster County Environmental Management Council requests formal full intervenor status under paragraph 2.715 of Rules of Procedure, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, in Docket #50-596 (New Haven) and #50-597 (Stuyvesant).

The Ulster County Environmental Management Council is an advisory body to the Ulster County Legislature and the Ulster County Planning Board in environmental matters. It concerns itself with those projects which will have an environmental impact on a county level.

The Town of Gardiner falls within Ulster County. Gardiner's Environmental Conservation Commission and the Board of Supervisors were informed of the choice of Gardiner as a potential site for two nuclear power plants or three coal-fired power plants on Monday, March 12, 1979. The impact of either of these power-generating facilities on the environment of the County is justification for our intervention.

The date of notification of the Town of Gardiner fell on the deadline date for request for intervenor status which is why our petition did not meet the deadline, however this particular set of circumstances seems to warrant consideration of this petition.
