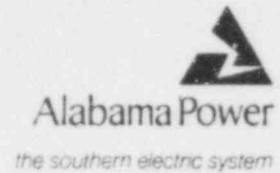



Clayton, Jr. to A. Schwencer

On May 1, 1979 Alabama Power Company mailed its Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant - Unit No. 1 Inservice Testing Program to Mr. A. Schwencer under the provisions of 10CFR50.55a(g), which states it shall be revised at each 20-month interval of plant operation.

Alabama Power Company was notified by Mrs. Diggs, NRC, that a fee was required for review. Therefore, Alabama Power Company submits a check for \$4,000.00 in accordance with 10CFR170.22. The approval is considered Class II because it involves only a single safety issue and is deemed not to involve a significant hazards consideration.
