SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated on December 13, 2018, by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region III, to determine whether a senior specialist for environmental health and safety at the Cardinal Health facility in Indianapolis, Indiana, was discriminated against by management for raising safety concerns.

Based upon the evidence developed, the allegation that a senior specialist for environmental health and safety at Cardinal Health was discriminated against by management for raising safety concerns is not substantiated.
