IE Bulletin 79-06A

Item 13 of IE Bulletin 79-06A (as modified by Revision No. 1 of April 18, 1979) requested that, within 30 days of receipt of the Bulletin, we:

- (1) Propose changes, as required, to those technical specifications which must be modified as a result of our implementing the preceding items of Bulletin 79-06A, and
- (2) Identify design changes necessary in order to effect long term resolutions of those items.

The only Technical Specification amendment we have identified to date was related to the safety injection trip logic, and was forwarded to the Division of Operating Reactors on May 2, 1979. It was approved as Amendment 48 to Operating License DPR-31 and Amendment 40 to Operating License DPR-41 on May 4, 1979.

At the present time we have not identified any design changes, other than those described in our initial response to the Bulletin, that are necessary for long term resolution of other issues raised by the Bulletin. If we identify any design changes or additional Technical Specification changes during our continuing review, your office will be advised.
