As counsel for Omaha Public Power District, we hereby submit three (3) signed originals and nineteen (19) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment of Operating License," together with forty (40) copies of the proposed technical specifications and safety discussion. The application seeks to remove the requirements that, when one train of a redundant system is inoperable, non-redundant pumps and valves in the remaining train be cycled.

The Amendment is exempted from the fee requirements of 10 C.F.R. §170.22 since it is submitted in response to a Commission request and is intended to simplify and
