Pursuant to the terms of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to request the following information on behalf of myself and my fellow members of Prairie Alliance:

- (1) Copies of any NRC documents pertaining to the safety of Clinton Units I and II (dockets 70-461 and 70-462) or to the accidents, risks, probabilities, and consequences not contained in the present NRC 70-461 and 70-462 public files, such as are maintained in the NRC PDR. We refer especially to cited reports that in the order repudiating parts of WASH-1400, the NRC commissioners directed the staff to review all existing plant licenses with regard to their reliance on WASH-1400.
- (2) Copies of NRC documents pertaining specifically to the generic safety of all BWRs and/or GE BWRs. Should this include reports too numerous and/or lengthy to conveniently provide, please limit your response to those documents produced since the order repudiating the Rasmussen report. However, we would appreciate in this event receiving a list of documents produced prior to this repudiation and information of where we may obtain each report.
- (3) The official NRC list of Generic Unresolved Safety Problems for BWR's and/or GE BWR's.
- (4) The text of any NRC documents instructing the designers, engineers, constructors, or operators of BWR's or all reactors (but not specifically PWR's) existing procedures and practices as a result of the WASH-1400 repudiation or subsequent events, including the accident at Three Mile Island.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation and speedy reply.
