RESOLUTION NUMBER 79-4.1

RESOLVED REQUESTING NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION TO REVIEW  
THE ST. LUCIE NUCLEAR PLANT ON HUTCHINSON ISLAND

WHEREAS, this Board has made the following deter-  
minations of fact:

1. The St. Lucie Nuclear Plant is located just  
north of the Martin County line on Hutchinson Island in St.  
Lucie County, Florida; and,
2. This Board is greatly concerned for the residents  
of Martin County relative to the recent happenings in Pennsylv-  
ania; and,
3. In view of these concerns, this Board deems it  
necessary and proper to request the Nuclear Regulatory Com-  
mission to review the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant and submit  
findings to this Board concerning safety precautions at said  
plant that will alleviate the possibility of a similar  
occurrence at the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS OF MARTIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

A. This Board respectfully requests the Nuclear  
Regulatory Commission to review the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant  
on Hutchinson Island in St. Lucie County, Florida, and submit  
findings to this Board concerning safety precautions at said  
plant that will alleviate the possibility of a similar  
occurrence at the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant.

B. A certified copy of this resolution shall be  
transmitted by the County Auditor's Office to the Nuclear  
Regulatory Commission, to the Governor of the State of Florida,  
and to the U.S. Senators and Congressmen who represent Martin






