NOTICE OF APPEAL


On June 13, 1978 the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, the Sauk-Suiattle Indian Tribe and the Swinomish Tribal Community filed a Petition to Intervene in the above proceeding. On November 24, 1978, the Licensing Board issued a "Decision and Order Granting Intervention." The Applicants appealed on December 11, 1978. The Appeal Board vacated the Licensing Board's order and remanded the question of intervention in its Memorandum and Order of January 12, 1979, and more fully explained its action in its Decision of January 29, 1979.

On April 24, 1979, at a conference among the parties the Licensing Board orally announced the decision to deny the Petition to Intervene on remand and indicated that time for appeal would run from the issuance of a written Order. The Licensing Board's written Order Not To Entertain Nontimely Petition to Intervene was issued on June 1, 1979.


