Dear Barry:

Enclosed please find the stipulated contention on emergency planning which we agreed to on Tuesday, June 12, 1979. The original stipulation has been executed by Assistant Attorney General Stephen M. Leonard, on behalf of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and William Abbott, Esq., on behalf of the Cleetons. George Lewald, counsel for the Applicants, has reviewed the stipulation, but does not wish to sign the document. Mr. Lewald's office has indicated to me today that the Applicants continue to oppose the emergency planning contention on the merits, and take no position on the wording of the stipulated contention.

It is my understanding that you will execute the stipulation on behalf of the NRC Staff, and file the original document by Friday, June 15, 1979. As per our agreement, I am filing today the stipulated contention as executed by the Commonwealth and the Cleetons, with a transmittal letter to the Licensing Board indicating that the staff concurs with the final language of the contention, and that upon execution of the original stipulation, you intend to file same.
