STIPULATION

Counsel for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (Commonwealth), Alan R. and Marian W. Cleeton (Cleetons), the NRC Staff (Staff) and Boston Edison Company et al. (Applicants), hereby stipulate and agree to the following contention of the Commonwealth and the Cleetons in this proceeding, subject to the approval of the Licensing Board.

Given the guidelines established in Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50 and the proposed amendment thereto (43 FR 37433):

- 1) An acceptable emergency plan cannot be developed to protect persons within and beyond the LPZ of the proposed site; and
- 2) The Applicant's preliminary emergency plans as set forth in its Preliminary
