POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2

On July 17, 1979, we received a telephone call from Mr. Trammell of your staff concerning our letters of April 25 and May 2, 1979, which provided our response to IE Bulletin 79-07. In the May 2, 1979 letter we had concluded that the results of the reanalyses of the four safety related piping lines, as specified in the April 25, 1979 letter, indicated that all pipe stresses and support and constraint loads are within code acceptable limits. Mr. Trammell requested confirmation that the code limits referred to were the same as those specified in the Point Beach Nuclear Plant Final Facility Description and Safety Analysis Report (FFDSAR). We hereby confirm that the results of the analyses were within the acceptable limits of the applicable piping code as specified in the FFDSAR.
