In developing testimony on the alternative sites issue for the Skagit Nuclear Project hearings, we are informed that you co-applicant, Pacific Power & Light, sponsored a study exploring the suitability of West Roosevelt, Washington for nuclear and coal-fired power generating facilities.

We feel that testimony on the West Roosevelt site, as evaluated by PP & L or their consultants, should be entered into the record of the Skagit proceedings. Since we have been unable to locate a witness qualified to describe the study's results and the site's suitability as an alternative to Skagit, we request that you arrange through your co-applicant to provide such a witness, as well as a copy of the West Roosevelt report, at the July 19th session of the Skagit hearings.
