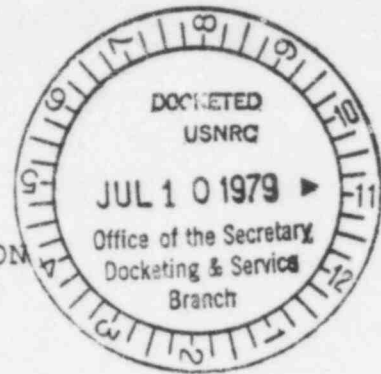

TUGCO'S REPLY TO TEX-LA'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On July 2, 1979 Tex-La served by mail a motion for extension of time to respond to TUGCO's First Set of Interrogatories. As was noted in Tex-La's motion, TUGCO is amenable to an extension of time to July 24, 1979, but not to Tex-La's request for two more weeks beyond that date, to August 6, 1979. Adherence to the earlier date is necessary to permit TUGCO's counsel to have a day to review responses to interrogatories prior to deposing individuals associated with Tex-La's members.


