Dear Ms. Morrison:

This is in reference to the dated August 14, 2019, notifying the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a change of control of NRC License No. 47-19142-01 to Princeton Community Hospital Association, Inc. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Please provide a complete, clear description of the transaction, and include a pre- and post-transaction organizational chart showing the corporate structure of the license holder and its parent companies, if any.
2. Please describe any changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc. that will occur as a result of the change of control. Please confirm that the licensee name, mailing address, and contact information, including phone numbers will remain the same.
3. Please describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program, including any known contamination, at the time of the transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.
4. Please confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.
5. Please confirm that both transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
6. Please confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

7. Please have a senior management representative from Princeton Community Hospital Association, Inc. concur with all statements and commitments made in the letter dated August 14, 2019 and the response to this request.
8. In order for the NRC to determine if this change of control is to a "known entity," please indicate if Princeton Community Hospital Association, Inc. possesses any NRC or Agreement State licenses. If so, please provide a copy.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. Please respond within 30 days of the date of this request.
