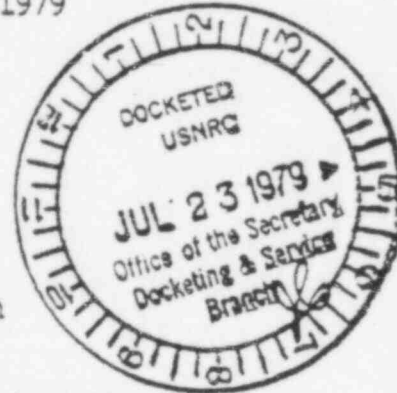

Dear Sir or Madame:

Please accept this letter as my petition for leave to intervene as a full party in the above proceeding. I reside with my wife and son in Richmond, Texas approximately 15 miles east of the proposed site. I work in Rosenberg, Texas approximately 13 miles east of the proposed site. I also own real property which fronts on the Brazos River and which is located about 13 miles east of the proposed site. I buy my electricity from Houston Lighting & Power Co.

I am concerned that my families' health may be affected by the operation of the proposed facility including the transportation to the facility of nuclear materials and the transportation and/or disposal of waste materials from the facility.

I am also concerned about the effect of same on my property values.

I am also concerned about the effect of same on my electricity rates.

I have not previously intervened (1) because I was initially not aware of the intervention procedures as set out in prior Federal Register notices, and (2) because prior intervention notices stated that petitions should be limited to addressing changes made in the plans for the proposed facility or information not previously available.


