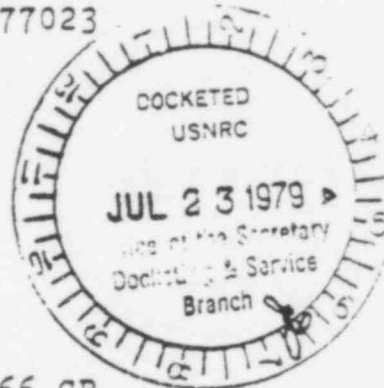

PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

I hereby petition for leave to intervene as a full party in this proceeding pursuant to the Notice of 6/18/79 published at 44 F.R. 35062. I am entitled to intervene as a full party by virtue of the following facts and reasons:

1. I reside within fifty (50) miles of the site of the proposed plant, and my base of normal, everyday activities is within a fifty (50) mile radius of the site.
2. I have a direct and personal interest and concern in the health and safety of myself and my family, and in our use and enjoyment of the natural resources within a fifty mile radius of the plant.
3. Adequate safeguards are not provided in the construction and operation of nuclear power reactors as demonstrated by a history of the failure of safety equipment to operate adequately and the disappearance of plutonium, a highly toxic material.
