
Dear Sir:

Pursuant to your most recent Order concerning construction defects and improper use of materials at Marble Hill, Save The Valley (STV) wishes to state that a suspension of construction should continue indefinitely.

It is our opinion that your Order is entirely too confining and does not allow for reasonable direct and cross-examination of any and all investigators who have been allowed on site, at Marble Hill. Kindly note that STV on or about June 6, 1979, requested an independent engineer be allowed on site for the purpose of reasonable discovery. Either the N.R.C. has denied our request for same or simply has not responded.

It is our intention to closely watch the movements of the N.R.C. in the coming weeks and months, and to promptly object to any resumption of construction in Safety I categories until and unless the N.R.C. makes public its findings and the methods and expertise used to determine such findings.
